CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

On November 30, 2015, the Texas State Board of Dental Examiners (Board) proposes this Cease and Desist Order (Order) against JOHN DOE.

The Board has received information and possesses certain evidence indicating that an individual operating out of 1208 Dobie Drive, #A, Austin, Texas 78753 has violated provisions of the Dental Practice Act (the Act), codified at Tex. Occ. Code §§ 251 through 257.

Failure to file a written request for a hearing on this Order prior to December 21, 2015, will render this Order immediately effective and non-appealable in accordance with Tex. Occ. Code § 264.0525(b).

Pursuant to authority granted at Tex. Occ. Code § 264.0525, the Board finds and issues the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

On April 7, 2014, the Board received a complaint concerning the unlicensed practice of dentistry by an individual at 1208 Dobie Drive, #A, Austin, Texas 78753. Specifically, the complainant alleged that the individual performed orthodontic work on a family member. This conduct constitutes the unlicensed practice of dentistry, as defined by Tex. Occ. Code § 251.003, and is a violation of Tex. Occ. Code § 256.001 and may be subject to criminal prosecution.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

THE INDIVIDUAL OPEARTING OUT OF 1208 DOBIE DR., #A, AUSTIN, TEXAS 78753, **CEASE AND DESIST** from any further action in the state of Texas in connection with the unlicensed practice of dentistry.
