**CEASE AND DESIST ORDER**

On April 6, 2016, the Texas State Board of Dental Examiners (Board) proposes this Cease and Desist Order (Order) against AZIEL E. FLORES.

The Board has received information and possesses certain evidence indicating that Aziel E. Flores has violated provisions of the Dental Practice Act (the Act), codified at Tex. Occ. Code §§ 251 through 257.

Failure to file a written request for a hearing on this Order prior to April 27, 2016, will render this Order immediately effective and non-appealable in accordance with Tex. Occ. Code § 264.0525(b).

Pursuant to authority granted at Tex. Occ. Code § 264.0525, the Board finds and issues the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

On January 24, 2016, the Board received a complaint concerning the unlicensed practice of dentistry by an individual named Aziel E. Flores at 2424 Las Palmas Drive, Port Arthur, Texas. Specifically, the complainant alleged that Aziel E. Flores told the complainant that he could perform a teeth cleaning at the specified address. In addition, Aziel E. Flores represented to the public through a website that he could perform deep cleanings. This conduct constitutes the unlicensed practice of dentistry, as defined by Tex. Occ. Code § 251.003, and is a violation of Tex. Occ. Code § 256.001 and may be subject to criminal prosecution.

**ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

AZIEL E. FLORES, **CEASE AND DESIST** from any further action in the state of Texas in connection with the unlicensed practice of dentistry.
