**5. COMMITTEE REPORTS.**

**a. Licensing Committee Report.** Ms. Stine reported the Licensing Committee met to discuss the administration of the current Jurisprudence examination and the nitrous monitoring examinations through Prometric. She stated that the contract with Prometric will not be renewed when it expires on October 31, 2006. The Committee considered alternatives to the administration of these two exams. For Jurisprudence the Committee discussed an alternative method to knowledge assess by making available an online, interactive process offered by a company based in Austin, eStrategy Solution, Inc. She then called upon Ms. Sanders to brief the Board on alternatives.

Ms. Sanders stated that the Committee and Staff have looked at the transitioning from the current exam process with Prometric for all those required to take Texas Jurisprudence. That would involve any new applicant for licensure and board order compliance candidates.

Ms. Sanders stated that she and Dr. Zukowski met with representatives from eStrategy Solutions, is a Texas-based online e-learning provider, which delivers training and certification solutions for government entities and other professional organizations. She stated that eStrategy Solutions is also a state-approved vendor through the Department of Information Resources with a successful track record with other state regulatory agencies.

Ms. Sanders stated that eStrategy Solutions has made available an assessment of knowledge relative to Texas Jurisprudence where a candidate can log on from any computer, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, create a log in

and purchase the assessment, paying a fee of no more than what Prometric charges for a current examination. The services of eStrategy Solutions would begin effective November 1, 2006.

Ms. Stine reported that the Committee reviewed the current Nitrous Oxide Monitoring Certification Examination process which involves the candidate purchasing a study guide then taking the exam at Prometric. Since the SBDE will no longer have a mechanism in place for administration of this exam effective November 1, 2006, staff is requesting the Board consider changing the exam requirement to a course requirement much like the Pit and Fissure Sealant Certification currently in place.

Ms. Stine stated that if the Board approves the change to a course requirement format, staff will convene a committee of stakeholders to determine course objectives and bring proposed rules to the Board at its next meeting for consideration.
