Dr. Ramos reported that the Committee met on July 13, 2012 to discuss and consider new and existing rules 108.50 through 108.63.

6.1. Professional Recovery Network (PRN) Report. The Board reviewed the report submitted by Ms. Courtney Bolin, LMSW, Program Director of PRN.

6.2. Western Regional Examining Board (WREB) Report. Dr. Ramos reported that the WREB Dental Exam Review Board (DERB) meeting held on July 18, 2012. Discussion included committee recommendations on treatment plan answer keys and the implementation of a penalty for the situation where a candidate ignores the floor examiner's directive to submit a modification request to the grading area. Dr. Ramos also reported that WREB has elected new Board Members for 2013.

6.3. Western Regional Examining Board (WREB) Dental Hygiene Examining Review Board (HERB) Report. Ms. Grant submitted a written report on the WREB HERB meeting which was held in Denver, CO on July 17, 2012.

Ms. Grant's report covered the composition of the HERB, the approval of the 2013 Dental Hygiene Exam Schedule and approval of reports from the three committees of the Board: Dental Hygiene, Local Anesthesia, Restorative and Process of Care committees. The HERB statistician presented year to date information on each exam type and that Dr. Ben Lakey, PhD, presented a review on the reasoning, process and implementation of the new board governance structure which took effect January 1, 2012.

WREB will host two restorative educator forums and two hygiene educator forums during October and November 2012 respectively. Her report also included information on the need for educator examiners to rotate out of the exam pool in order to allow new examiners for new program to participate in the exam process. The 2013 HERB meeting will be held in Santa Fe, NM, on July 16, 2013.
